

# argyle christmas



A free pattern by Meredith Daniel of Olivia Jane Handcrafted

**Finished size: 45" x 55"**

**Materials Needed:**

*Quilt top:*

20 fat quarters: 10 festive, 10 low volume  
(I used a fat quarter pack of Tinsel from Westwood Acres plus a few Cotton+Steel basics I already had.)

*Quilt back:*

2 yd plus a small strip, or 4 yd for a solid backing

*Binding:* ½ yd

Rotary cutter and cutting mat

Coordinating thread



**Cut:**

From your ten main fabrics, cut 6 A pieces from each print

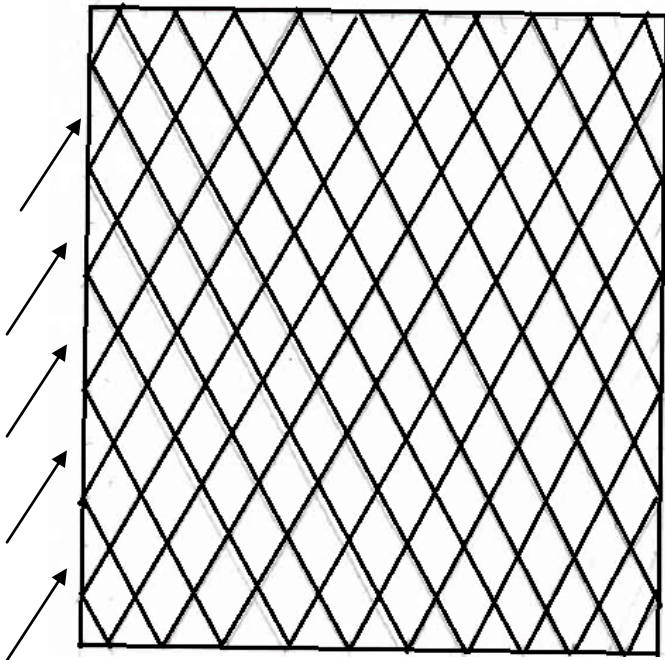
From 8 of your low volume fabrics, cut 5 A pieces and 2 C pieces from each print

From the remaining two fabrics, cut 5 B pieces and 2 D pieces from each print

From your binding, cut 5 2.5" x WOF strips

**Sew:**

Layout your quilt to your liking, and begin sewing together diagonal rows with a ¼" seam. Press the seams to one side and alternate sides with every row.



*Sew upward diagonal rows like the arrows to the left show.*

Then sew rows together with ¼" seams and press open or to one side.

### **Finish:**

Prepare your backing and baste your quilt. Quilt to your liking and then square up. Finish off with binding. If you would like a detailed tutorial for perfect binding every time, check out my [Picture Perfect Binding Tutorial here](#).
